PARENT BEHAVIOR FORM

Oakleaf Sports Association, Inc. is committed to providing your child a safe and healthy environment in which to participate in the athletic programs that we offer. Along with our chartered organizations, Babe Ruth and North Florida Youth Football & Cheer, we stress the importance of good sportsmanship and teamwork in addition to teaching fundamental skills. Please keep in mind that you are responsible not only for your own behavior, but also that of your child (or children) and any guest(s) that you may invite into the park.

The following guidelines are provided to remind you how you can assist us in accomplishing these goals:

- 1) Respect our volunteers. If you have a disagreement, do not discuss it in front of the children.
- 2) Respect the umpires and officials. Teach your child to do the same.
- 3) Children need encouragement. Criticism and negativity may cause a child to be less enthusiastic.
- 4) Be positive with remarks and actions. If you have nothing nice to say, do not say anything.
- 5) Adhere to posted park rules.

Consequently, Oakleaf Sports Association, Inc. will not tolerate inappropriate behavior. Any verbal abuse, attempt to intimidate, inappropriate language, and/or any other act which lacks control toward a player, coach, official, or any other parent or volunteer by you or any member of your party, the person(s) will be asked to leave the event immediately and will receive a written warning, probation, suspension, and/or a one-year ban from all events.

If a second offense occurs, the person(s) will be banned for the remainder of the season. Any person who physically assaults any player, coach, official, volunteer, or spectator will be banned from Oakleaf Sports Association, Inc. for a minimum of one full year. Physical assault includes, but is not limited to, striking, slapping, pushing, spitting, kicking, shaking, etc.

If you are involved in an incident or witness to one, you should contact your League Player Agent. Should any other problems arise, feel free to contact in the following order:

- 1) Team Manager/Head Coach
- 2) Commissioner
- 3) Director of the respective sport the incident occurred
- 4) Vice-President
- 5) Executive Board
